

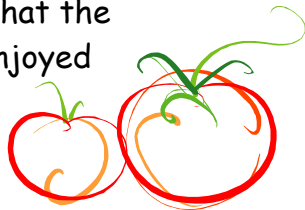
The Eco Team - making our school Greener

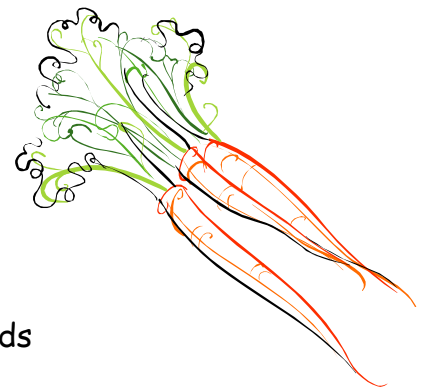
